Each has his own favorite memories of Our Town... mine may be when I was teaching English in East Java in 1979, and my group of college seniors put on this play for their friends and families. Every time the Stage Manager said "Nice town, y'know what I mean?" in his wonderful Madurese accent, I thought about my own town thousands of miles away, feeling both impossibly far away from home as well as right at home where I was, marveling at how this (now) old play works its simple magic wherever people open up to it.

By the mid-nineteen-thirties, Thornton Wilder was tired and suspicious of tendencies towards realism in theatre, feeling that the emphasis on precious museum-like walls and sets boxed in and stifled life and truth. His response was *Our Town*: No curtain. No scenery... "Moliere said that for the theatre all he needed was a platform and a passion or two. The climax of this play needs only five square feet of boarding and the passion to know what life means

to us.

He was writing in 1937 about a time thirty years earlier, and here we are sixty years later putting what he wrote on stage. Differences from today will be obvious, although more striking, perhaps, will be the similarities. Enjoy your stay.
